


Annual Report – Season 2021



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President's Report - Malcolm Arnold





After a shortened 2020 season due to Corona virus Epping FC had record registrations again in 2021. Most pleasingly we continue to see strong growth in player numbers in our youngest U6 age group with 10 new U6 mixed teams and 3 new U6 girls teams in 2021 - these new additions are the future of the club and are our best indicator of future player numbers for the subsequent years. We also continue to see good growth in our female player numbers with Epping FC currently having the largest female participation across the entire North West Sydney Football Association.

With the continued growth of player numbers, the club was able to secure Epping boys high school football field as an additional home ground on Saturdays for season 2021. The grass was long, and it was tough going early in the season but this ended up being a good facility to provide our teams another home base away from West Epping.

The committee of Epping FC continues to look for opportunities to reinvest in our players and this season offered all Epping FC players new shorts and socks as part of registration - this helped our teams look their best on game day with no excuses for being out of uniform. We also for the first time in season 2021 invested in some dedicated goalkeeper training for all our dedicated goal keepers from U11-U18 - conducted by highly regarding goal keeper coach Ken Greenhead from Progressive Goal Keeping - this was well received and highly valued by our dedicated players who take on this special role in many of our teams.

We also saw a revised playing shirt for season 2021 with our new sponsor Betty Ockerlander of McGrath real estate. The design saw Epping Fc return to its traditional shirt from back in the 80's and we also introduced a new away kit that went back to the club early days when the club colours were brown, yellow and white!

The 2021 season was ultimately cut short with another Coronavirus lockdown late June. The season never restarted, and premiers were declared after 10 rounds in most competitions. This saw 8 Epping FC teams declared premiers - 18/1 Red girls, AA1 ladies, O30/1 ladies, O30/2 ladies, 15/3 Blue boys, 14/1 boys, 15/1 boys, and our 45/3 men - congratulations

We unfortunately did not get to celebrate the season end with lockdowns in place and for the second year in a row did not hold our end of season presentation days and senior night.

Thanks again to the great volunteers we have across the club including our dedicated and passionate committee and the many volunteer coaches and managers whom without we would not be able to have teams play - you r efforts are truly magnificent and undervalued by our players.

Let's hope for a full season in 2022.



EFC Media Matters

The Club appointed a Social Media and Newsletter Officer to the Committee in the 2021 season, to trial expansion of member communications beyond email and find alternate ways of collating weekly Match Reports. Overall, the Club's Facebook engagement increased 510% to 8,800 people reached during the reporting period November 2020-November 2021. Our page saw a peak of 2,100 people reached with our registration offer to U6s. This is a pleasing result despite early season closure, and an additional means of supporting our valued sponsors in increasing their reach in the community we serve. The Club currently operates under the NWSF Social Media policy.



Treasurer's Report

With the cancellation of the season due to COVID, our financial reports, for the second year in a row, are again not representative of a normal season.

For the 2021 season, EFC has made a profit of \$42,973.97 and I make the following comments:

Revenue – increased by \$19,000 compared to 2020

Registration fees were up by about \$8,000 on last year

West Epping Summer Soccer was again a great contributor to EFC. EFC earned \$27,000 from the 2020 Summer Soccer season which is \$7,000 more than last year

Sponsorship was up by \$7,000, mainly due to our new agreement with Betty Ockerlander at McGrath.

We received \$1,000 from a sports grant and \$5,000 from the Office of Sport for the purchase of our new defibrillators

Expenses – increased by \$27,000 compared to 2020

We spent \$11,000 more on club clothing this year which related to the purchase of our new shirts with new Betty Ockerlander/McGrath branding

Equipment purchases increased by \$11,000 – new balls, bench seats etc

Due to the season's cancellation, ground hire paid for 2021 is only 50% of a full season. It was still \$6,000 more than last year because Council didn't charge any ground hire fees for the whole 2020 season due to COVID.

Presentation expenses were approximately the same as last year, but this is down on previous years, as we were again unable to hold our junior or senior presentation events

Cash on Hand as at 31/08/21 was approximately \$270,500. We still have funds to collect from Parramatta Council re the ground hire refund and payments to various suppliers to pay for trophies, premiership gifts, etc. Upon settlement of our debtors and creditors, we will have approximately \$260,000 cash on hand.
